The Chicago Manual of Style was first written in 1891 by the University of Chicago Press in order to standardize the process of revising and editing the many papers proofreaders were being given.

How to Format a Chicago Style Paper - ThoughtCo

Chicago papers start with a title page. The title of the paper should be 1/3 of the way down. If there is a title and subtitle, the two should be on different lines, separated by a colon. About 2/3 of the way down the page should contain your name, the date, and any other information required by your instructor.

Double-space the text of the paper. Use left-justified text, which will have a ragged right edge. Do not use fully (newspaper-style) justified text. Use a 1/2" indent for paragraph beginnings, block quotes and hanging (bibliography) indents. Number the pages in the top right corner of the paper, beginning with the first page of text.
